

# LEE COUNTY MASTER GARDENERS SCHOLARSHIP FUND

## Horticulture-Related Summer Camps for Parent of Beekeeping Camp Attendee Mississippi State University, Starkville, Mississippi

In May 2017, the Lee County Master Gardeners of Tupelo, Mississippi, established a Scholarship Fund for Horticulture-Related Summer Camps conducted at Mississippi State University in Starkville, Mississippi. Potential scholarship recipients who may apply include students, teachers, or the parent of a Beekeeping Camp attendee. Available scholarships will be paid annually. The recipient of the scholarship must meet the following criteria:

1. Must be a resident of Lee County, Mississippi
2. Must be willing to attend the entire Beekeeping Camp with their Child unless in the case of emergency
3. Must be of good moral character and have financial need

The Lee County Master Gardeners Board of Officers will administer the scholarship program in conjunction with the Lee County Master Gardeners Summer Camp Scholarship Committee. Any scholarships awarded will be on a year-to-year basis. A parent who is the recipient of the Beekeeping Camp Scholarship one year is ineligible for consideration for said scholarship the following year. Scholarship funds will be made payable to Mississippi State University to be submitted by the recipient to MSU with the recipient paying the remainder of the camp cost.

Beekeeping Camp Cost: \$450.00 • Beekeeping Camp Scholarship: \$250.00

Applications will be available on or about February 15 to March 31 during the year for which application is being made. **Applications must be returned no later than March 31 of the year in which application is being made or postmarked no later than said date.**
